- stock/samples held has been either sold or distributed to support the cross-country teams and run leader kit.
- The clubs bank balance (and reserves) have reduced by £1.4k (£1.3k) as a result of the current spending plans.
- The funds held are sufficient to retain the membership fee at its current level for the next membership year whilst also continuing with the same level of investment in provision to members

Members' Q&A

Question: The icy conditions show up that the track isn't in great condition. I know that Abbey View Community Athletics Track got quite a bit of publicity when they took on responsibility for the St Albans track and I wondered:

- 1. Did the Arrows committee consider using the St Albans track for our sessions?
- 2. Is the St Albans track in better condition? (it's a long time since I've been on the track)
- 3. Because it's a reasonably local initiative, should we be supporting Abbey View Community Athletics Track by using the track?

I have no idea on costs and whether there would be timing conflicts with sessions, and I suspect that Stockwood Park may be easier/quicker to get to for many Arrows members.

Answer: We did make some enquiries with St Albans and there is the ability to share on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. There is no space at all on Tuesdays/Thursdays.

Like for many of the club runs we are getting reduced numbers of attendees at Stockwood and would have to look at whether another evening (Mon/Weds) would work and would compete against possible S&C sessions that have also been suggested.
